TUITION & FEES (NSDA)

BASIC EXPENSES *(No tuition increase!)*

-Application Fee: *

- Application Fee by March 19, 2010 waived
- Application Fee after March 19, 2010 \$50.00
- Application Fee after July 16, 2010 \$100.00

-Comprehensive Fee* (all students) \$250.00

-Tuition:

- Regular** (monthly installment @ \$692.70)..... \$6927.00
(5% discount applies if paid in full at enrollment, or 2% discount if paid by semester)
- Tuition Recovery Insurance*** (Unless year is paid in advance - 3.4% of tuition)..... \$235.52
- ESL** \$10,632.00
(Full tuition at enrollment, early payment discount not applicable)

OTHER EXPENSES

-Lunch Tickets: (Purchased ahead of time – not charged to account)

- Grades K - 3 (20 meals w/ milk)** (\$4.00/meal) \$80.00
- Grades 4 - 8 (20 meals w/ milk)** (\$5.00/meal) \$100.00
- Milk Only, Grades K – 8th (20 counts)** (\$0.75/milk) \$15.00

-AM/PM Supervision:

- 1 student** (per hour / 5-minute increments) \$3.00
(after 5:30 PM - \$3.00 per minute)
- 2 or more siblings** (per hour, each / 5-minute increments) \$2.50
(after 5:30 PM - \$3.00 per minute)

-Locker Fee (whole school year, 7th and 8th grades) \$10.00

-Graduation Fee, 8th Grade \$75.00

*Non- Refundable

TUITION: Payable annually, by semester, or monthly. Monthly payments through ACH or credit card (Visa, MasterCard, American Express & Discover) is strongly encouraged (due every 15th of the month). No refunds will be made for a partial month upon a student’s withdrawal.

FAMILY DISCOUNT: 5% tuition discount is given to the 2nd, 3rd (etc.) sibling enrolled at HMA K-8.

AUTOMATIC PAYMENT AUTHORIZATION FORMS (green sheet) for ACH or **CREDIT CARD PAYMENT** must be completed and submitted to the office at the time of registration if you choose either of these payment methods. They must be renewed each school year.

DUE AT REGISTRATION: Comprehensive fee plus first monthly installment of tuition and Tuition Recover Insurance if you’re not paying tuition in full.
